THE COMMUNITY IS INVITED TO PARTICIPATE IN PUBLIC MEETINGS TO HELP SHAPE THE FUTURE OF SAN CLEMENTE'S BEACHES, PARKS AND RECREATION

November 10, 2016...San Clemente, California...The San Clemente Beaches, Parks and Recreation Department will be hosting public meetings to get the public's input and help establish priorities for the future of beaches, parks, trails, recreation facilities, programs, and services in San Clemente.

Pamela Passow, Assistant Director of Beaches, Parks and Recreation Department said, "This 10 year Beaches, Parks, and Recreation Master Plan will set the framework for decision makers in the planning, maintenance, and development and/or rehabilitation of our beaches, parks, and recreation facilities." The City has hired PROS Consulting, Inc., a national parks and recreation management consulting firm to lead the project. The meetings will be held at the San Clemente Community Center located at 100 N. Calle Seville, scheduled as follows:
