





EXTENDED TEMPORARY CLOSURE: Camino de Estrella Northbound On-Ramp

CAMINO DE ESTRELLA RAMP CLOSURE: The Camino de Estrella loop on-ramp to northbound I-5 will be closed for nine days beginning Nov. 14. The closure, which will allow crews to reconstruct the portion of the ramp where it meets the freeway, is scheduled from 12:01 a.m. Monday, Nov. 14, to 5 a.m. Wednesday, Nov. 23. Motorists will be detoured to southbound I-5 and Avenida Vista Hermosa to access northbound I-5.

NOTE: Immediately following this work, the contractor expects to remove the temporary concrete barriers between the northbound Camino de Estrella on-ramp and northbound I-5. This will allow direct access to northbound I-5 from Camino de Estrella and to Camino Las Ramblas from northbound I-5.

Here is the suggested detour for the closure of the loop on-ramp:



PICO BRIDGE DEMO

Avenida Pico Bridge Demolition; Nightly Pico Closures: Crews are scheduled to begin demolishing the remainder of the existing bridge over Avenida Pico on Nov. 14, which will require closing Pico. The demolition and closures will be from 11 p.m. to 5 a.m. nightly Monday, Nov. 14, through Friday, Nov. 18, and again on Monday, Nov. 21, and Tuesday, Nov. 22.

This work may be loud and disruptive due to back-up alarms and construction activities. It must be performed at night, when lanes on Avenida Pico can be closed, for the safety of construction crews and the traveling public. There will be no pedestrian or bicyclist access on Avenida Pico underneath the bridge during demolition.
