## CONSTRUCTION HIGHLIGHTS



**Nighttime Pico Lane Closure:** The outside lane of westbound Avenida Pico will be closed from 10 p.m. to 5 a.m. tonight, May 12, to allow crews to complete the final concrete pour for the retaining wall along Pico.

**Median Demo Work:** Crews are continuing nighttime demolition of the I-5 median barrier and adjacent pavement between Camino Capistrano and Camino de Estrella. The work must be performed at night because it requires lane closures - typically from 10 p.m. to 5 a.m. Monday through Friday - to ensure flying debris does not impact motorists. Demolition work, below, is expected to last for the next several weeks.



The median is being realigned to accommodate the freeway widening and to improve the sight stopping distance for southbound motorists. Reconstruction of the median is expected to take several months.



## NEIGHBORING PROJECTS

***Update* NB I-5 El Camino Real Ramp Closure:** The northbound I-5 on-ramp at El Camino Real is expected to close intermittently from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m. weekdays through August. The closure is part of a safety improvement project to adjust the curve of I-5 at El Camino Real. The northbound I-5 off-ramp to El Camino Real is now open. **PCH Bridge Deck Replacement Project:** Caltrans is replacing the bridge deck on the loop on-ramp from eastbound Camino Las Ramblas to northbound I-5, and the ramp is expected to be closed until mid-June.
