CONSTRUCTION HIGHLIGHTS 

Nighttime Ramp Closures: The Camino Las Ramblas / PCH on-ramps to southbound I-5 are expected to close, beginning at 10 p.m. tonight, June 23, through 7 a.m. Saturday, June 24, for the installation of metal beam guard rails. Motorists should use Doheny Park Road and southbound Pacific Coast Highway to access southbound I-5.



DELAYED Median Demo Work: The contractor canceled this work as of 2:45 p.m. Friday. It has been rescheduled to begin on Monday night, June 26. Crews on Monday night are scheduled to begin demolishing a portion of the median concrete barrier on I-5 between Avenida Palizada and just south of Avenida Presidio. The work requires lane closures for the safety of the construction crew and traveling motorists, which must take place at night. Construction will occur from 10 p.m. to 5 a.m., for up to two weeks. The work is necessary to install overhead signs for the new carpool lanes. Please be advised that this work may be loud.



Median Work: Crews are continuing intermittent freeway lane closures from 10 p.m. to 5 a.m. Monday through Friday for median barrier work between Camino Capistrano and Camino de Estrella on northbound and southbound I-5. The median is being realigned to accommodate the freeway widening and to improve the sight stopping distance for southbound motorists. Reconstruction of the median is expected to take several months.

Avenida Pico Closures: Crews will continue removing falsework from the Avenida Pico bridge from 10 p.m. to 5 a.m. weeknights through the end of next week. The work requires full nighttime closures of Avenida Pico at the freeway bridge. All ramps are expected to be closed intermittently. Motorists should use Avenida Vista Hermosa and Calle Frontera as detours.
