

YOUTH BASEBALL HUB

The youth baseball complex is designed as a superior venue for league play and a comfortable setting for watching games.



Featuring three youth baseball fields with natural turf outfields, dirt base paths, and natural turf infields, the complex offers fully lighted fields year-round to maximize play during the fall and early spring sports seasons.

Shaded viewing areas from the sidelines and bleacher seating will accommodate up to 100 people behind each of the baseball field backstops. The youth baseball hub will provide youth with exclusive opportunities.

YOUTH SOCCER HUB

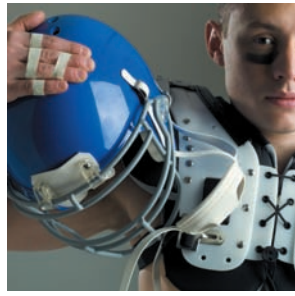
Filling an intense need for more opportunities for soccer play, the youth soccer hub will be equipped with two full-size soccer fields, two youth soccer fields, and one soccer practice field. All fields will be fully lighted to accommodate increased use during the fall and early spring sports season.



Spectators can enjoy shaded viewing areas located along the perimeter. A restroom/concessions building will be conveniently located for easy access. The end result will be a complex designed as both a comfortable, family setting to watch games, and a high-quality sports venue for sports play.

FOOTBALL HUB

The football fields offer many new opportunities for quality and accessible youth football play. The diversity of ball fields at La Pata/Vista Hermosa Community Park serve as beneficial community assets because they offer opportunities for recreation, education, and relaxation that contribute to the local quality of life, especially for young people.



AQUATICS COMPLEX

A new aquatics complex designed to accommodate competition-level events features a 50 meter x 25 yard competition pool with springboards and a 30' x 50' teaching/recreational pool.



Major design elements include:

- 50-meter competition pool
- Teaching/recreational pool
- Large deck space with shade arbors
- Seat wall planters
- Viewing terrace
- Generous seating and lounging areas
- 9,000 square foot bathhouse with concessions and storage

Serving the San Clemente community, the aquatics complex will provide residents of all ages with a wide-array of activities for optimal recreational enjoyment, including:

- Swimming classes
- Lap swimming
- Recreational swimming
- Water polo competitions & practice
- Swimming competition
- Team swimming practice
