Over his 33 years of Ministry, Fr. Jack has served in churches in Mission Viejo, Anaheim, Placentia, Westminster and Cypress before Our Lady of Fatima. In 1981, he followed a family tradition by joining the Air Force Reserve Chaplain Corps. He has served at March ARB, Bitburg AB Germany, Wright Patterson AFB, Langley AFB and for the last 7 years, at the Pentagon as the Mobilization Assistant to the Air Force Chief of Chaplains. He has been deployed to Korea in 1988, Saudi Arabia in 1993 and Alaska in 1995.

Father Jack enjoys spending time in the beautiful Sierra Nevada Mountains as well as flying over Southern California as a private pilot.
