What is the Evacuation Route for a Nuclear Emergency?

Should evacuation be necessary, Interstate 5 and Pacific Coast Highway provide our major evacuation routes. Traffic will be heavily controlled on surface streets leading to Interstate 5 and at all on highway on ramps. Northbound traffic will be stopped at SR 78 in Oceanside and southbound traffic will be stopped at the I-5/405 interchange.
