BEACHES AND PARKS MAINTENANCE DIVISION

Beaches & Parks assisted with record Labor Day weekend use of our parks and beaches, and with the remarkably popular Summer Beach Concert Series.

MARINE SAFETY DIVISION

Approximately 300,000 people enjoyed our beaches in August. Lifeguards performed 620 rescues, 204 medical aids, 6,173 preventative actions, and, gave 1,187 warnings for ordinances (numbers are accurate through August 27, 2013).

Recreation Programs

Summer classes and camps are officially over in San Clemente. Participants had the great, sunny weather all summer and took advantage of surf and pool classes.
