BEACHES AND PARKS MAINTENANCE DIVISION

May 15 marks the beginning of the 4 month period of more frequent mowing of parks' sport fields, more frequent trash pickup, restroom cleaning and beach sand grooming.

Beaches and Parks Maintenance awarded the Beach Trail Fence Repair contract, and will be taking the Playground Maintenance contract to City Council on June 18.

MARINE SAFETY DIVISION

Approximately 358,000 people enjoyed our beaches in May. Lifeguards performed 255 rescues, 83 medical aids, 2,054 preventative actions, and, gave 551 warnings for ordinances.
