SUBJECT: Demonstration of the new web-based, Preliminary Draft Centennial General Plan and

review of the Draft General Plan's status and recent changes to the project's work

schedule, tentative hearing dates and anticipated timeline for adoption.

SITUATION

At tonight's meeting, staff will demonstrate a working version of the Preliminary Draft Centennial General Plan. Although the General Plan website is still under construction, it is complete enough to demonstrate its organization, content and functionality. Staff expects that the website will be complete and publicly accessible by the end of this month.

At the meeting, staff will also provide an update on the status of the Draft Centennial General Plan, discuss anticipated review dates and discuss next steps. Since the Commission's last review of the Preliminary Draft Plan, we've made significant progress on two fronts: 1) the Planning Center and City staff prepared a "Public Hearing Draft" General Plan which incorporates the Commission's changes and additions, and 2) an Initial Environmental Study and Notice of EIR Preparation were prepared and publicly released. An early administrative version of the Public Hearing Draft was routed to City departments for review and the comment period is now closed. Non-substantive (i.e. typographical, grammatical) changes are being addressed by the consultant, with the Public Hearing Draft expected to be publicly released later this month. Policy- and program-related comments will be presented at Planning Commission hearings on the Draft, starting in mid-May.

According to the Planning Center, technical sections of the Draft EIR on noise, air quality and greenhouse gases have been delayed. Consequently, preparation and review of the Draft EIR will be delayed an estimated eight to ten weeks. This is expected to "push back" final City Council action on the new draft General Plan until September or October 2012. Key tentative dates and next steps include:
