Subject: HIGHEST POINT IN SAN CLEMENTE NAME SELECTION

Fiscal Impact: Yes. \$300 for directional signage with reflective coating and \$100 for a gift certificate awarded to the winner of the naming contest.

Summary: A "highest point" naming contest was authorized at the August 20, 2013 City Council meeting. Staff promoted the contest using various mediums such as press releases, City Facebook page, City website, letters to local school principals and the SC Alerts E-blast system and received 87 name ideas from residents. The winning name is "San Clemente Summit," submitted by Dave Pherrin.

Background: The purpose of the contest was to promote civic pride and good health through outdoor activity and leveraging the popularity of the San Clemente Coastal Trail to other trails in the San Clemente trail system by naming and publicizing the highest point. Directional signage will lead people to the highest point and deflect them away from the Richard and Donna O'Neill Conservancy native habitat reserve. San Clemente Boy Scout Eric Ord committed to raising funds for a sitting bench and monument signage at the highest point which is located on the Cristianitos Trail.

Discussion: At the conclusion of the contest on October 7th, a committee of hiking enthusiasts comprised of Tom Wicks of the City's Beaches, Parks & Recreation Commission, and residents Steve Netherby and Don Kunze met to review the names submitted. They also hiked to the highest point to ensure the selected name fit the location.

Recommended

Action: STAFF RECOMMENDS THAT the City Council name the highest point "San Clemente Summit" and authorize a \$400.00 transfer from Council Contingency Account #001-203-44900 to Other Operating Supplies Fund #001-203-42490 for the directional signage and gift certificate.
