SUCCESSOR AGENCY ACTIONS

Summary:

Under Health and Safety Code Section 34180, related to the dissolution of the Redevelopment Agency (RDA), the City Council (as the Successor) is required to take certain actions. These actions include the approval of the Recognized Obligation Payment Schedule (ROPS) and the approval of the Successor Agency's Administrative Budget. The attached ROPS addresses obligations for the July 1, 2012 to December 31, 2012 period.

This ROPS includes the Administrative Budget, the General Fund Advance (which was rejected), and a smaller amount related to the operating agreement (lease) for the Casa Romantica. The Casa Romantica is discussed in more detail below:

Casa Romantica Lease Obligation. The rental agreement with the Casa Romantica Cultural Center (CRCC) created an obligation under an amendment dated July 1, 2008 to perform certain maintenance items (see Exhibit 2), including an exterior painting every 10 years, which is currently due. This maintenance obligation is estimated to cost \$30,000 annually and the painting obligation to be \$80,000 every 10 years.

In addition to preparing the ROPS, the City is responsible for presenting an annual Administrative Budget (Exhibit 3) to the Oversight Board for approval. Although a minimum level of \$250,000 is in the law, this amount is subject to approval of the Oversight Board. As such, we are presenting an Administrative Budget in the annual amount of \$89,820 (\$44,660 semi-annually). This annual administrative budget is high in comparison to the costs listed on the ROPS. The dissolution of the RDA has required a large amount of staff time to meet all the various reporting requirements and inquiries by County and State agencies. In addition, the budget is based on costs allocated based on prior year activity and specific costs which may be required in the upcoming year.

- 1) Approve the Recognized Obligation Payment schedule for the period from July 1, 2012 to December 31, 2012.
- 2) Approve the Administrative Budget for the Successor Agency for FY 2013.

ATTACHMENT 2 - EXCERPT FROM LEASE AMENDMENT

AGENCY MAINTENANCE AND REIMBURSEMENT OBLIGATIONS

- The Agency shall be responsible only for the following maintenance activities and reimbursements:
- Maintenance of Casa Romantica's domestic water system from the meter to the building's internal plumbing fixtures.
- 3. Maintenance of Casa Romantica's sewer system from the main line to the building's internal plumbing fixtures.
- 4. Reimbursement to Tenant for the cost of labor and materials for replacement of all of Casa Romantica's main electrical panels, load centers/breakers, conduits, raceways and wiring to the extent that such replacement is necessary as a result of aging from regular use.
- 5. Maintenance of the roof of the Casa Romantica building.
- 6. Maintenance, inspection, certification and monitoring of fire suppression/sprinkler system.
- 7. Reimbursement to Tenant for any portion of the cost of repairs and replacement to the HVAC system determined necessary by the PM that exceed One Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$1,500) per year. In determining the costs of repairs and replacement, the costs related to the PM Program shall not be included.
- Maintenance, including removal and replacement as determined necessary by the
 Director of Beaches, Parks & Recreation, of all trees located on the Property that are over
 twenty (20) feet in height.
- 9. Maintenance of the exterior Property boundary fence, including, without limitation, spot treating and painting and, if determined necessary by the Director of Beaches, Parks & Recreation, replacement of said fence. The design and materials of any replacement fence shall be subject to the approval of the City Council.
- Painting of the exterior of the Casa Romantica building every ten (10) years, with the first such painting to be completed by April 1, 2012, and each subsequent painting to be completed by the tenth (10th) anniversary of the immediately prior painting.
- 11. Performance of annual termite inspections, provision of localized extermination treatments or complete eradication treatments, as determined necessary by the Director of Beaches, Parks & Recreation as a result of said inspections, and performance of any repairs necessitated by termite damage.
