ADOPTION OF FISCAL YEAR 2013 BUDGET

Summary:

On May 17, 2012, the City held a budget workshop on the proposed FY 2013 operating and capital improvement budget. A list of items for Council consideration was submitted within the transmittal letter of the proposed budget. Council approved General Fund changes adding \$22,410 for social services (committee request), an additional \$45,000 for social services to be allocated by the Human Affairs Committee, \$15,000 for the adopted Marine unit and \$1,000 for Grad night. The Clean Ocean Fee Assessment review was also approved in the amount of \$70,000 for the Clean Ocean Fund. These items were incorporated into the proposed budget.

On June 12, 2012, City Council held a public hearing on the proposed FY 2013 operating and capital improvement budget. City Council deliberated the funding related to the Downtown Business Association and the Chamber of Commerce; however, no changes were made to the funding levels.

All Funds:

FY 2013 all funds revenues and expenditures, including fund balances, total \$207.7 million. Excluding fund balances, revenues for all funds total \$108,654,080 and expenditures total \$117,182,420. Attachment "A" — All Funds Budget summary presents the total budget for FY 2013. A resolution (Attachment "B") has been prepared to adopt and approve the budget for the General Fund, Special Revenue Funds, Capital Project Funds, Debt Service Fund, Enterprise Funds, and Internal Services Funds.

General Fund:

The FY 2013 General Fund budget, based on the public hearing, reflects total revenues of \$49,503,250 and total expenditures of \$53,653,670. The FY 2013 General fund ending fund balance is \$18.2 million.

City Council has committed General fund balance, based on Fiscal Policy, for the Sustainability Reserve (\$10 million), the Emergency Reserve (9% of operating costs), and the Vista Hermosa Sports Park Operating Reserve (to fund the net operating costs of the Sports Park). In accordance with Governmental Accounting Standards Board (GASB) Statement 54 these funds are included as part of a resolution and are to be used only for the identified purposes. This commitment is binding unless removed in the same manner.

Even though employee negotiations are still in process, as part of the routine budget process, a resolution is presented to adopt changes to the salary schedules to include new positions or reclassifications. A resolution (Attachment "D") has been prepared to approvate revised salary schedule and new job descriptions, where applicable, for the following personnel actions: eliminating one Information Systems Technician (1.0 FTE) and creating a Technical Applications Specialist classification and authorizing one (1.0 FTE) position; eliminating one Code Compliance Manager (1.0 FTE) and creating a Code Compliance Supervisor classification and adding one (1.0 FTE) position; and assigning a salary grade for the flexibly-staffed Accounting Specialist II classification.

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN CLEMENTE, CALIFORNIA, ADOPTING THE COMMITMENT OF FUND BALANCE BASED ON THE FISCAL YEAR 2013 BUDGET

WHEREAS, the Governmental Accounting Standards Board (GASB) has issued Statement No. 54 – Fund Balance Reporting and Governmental Fund Type Definitions, which changes the terminology used for fund balance reporting on balance sheets of Governmental Funds, and;

WHEREAS, for financial statement reporting purposes, the GASB Statement defines restricted amounts as those that are constrained to specific purposes by their providers through constitutional provisions or enabling legislation; and

WHEREAS, for financial statement reporting purposes, the GASB Statement defines committed amounts as amounts that can only be used for specific purposes pursuant to constraints imposed by formal action of the City Council; and

WHEREAS, the City has established a General Fund emergency reserve equal to 9% of operating expenditures of the General Fund at the end of each fiscal year and be used only for the purposes identified in the City's Fiscal Policy; and

WHEREAS, the City has established a General Fund essential minimum fund balance policy. At the end of each fiscal year, the General Fund should have a Sustainability Reserve balance equal to \$10 million in the General Fund which shall be used only for the purposes identified in the City's Fiscal Policy; and

WHEREAS, the City has established a Vista Hermosa Sports Park Maintenance and Operations reserve, which provides to offset the annual net operating costs of the Vista Hermosa Sports Park.

NOW, THEREFORE, The City Council of the City of San Clemente does hereby resolve as follows.

Section 1. The City Council does hereby approve and adopt the Fund Balance and Reserve Policies in the Annual Budget for compliance with Governmental Accounting Standards Board statement No. 54, Fund Balance Reporting and Governmental Fund Type definitions

Section 2. The City Clerk shall certify to the passage and adoption of this resolution and enter it into the book of original resolutions.

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN CLEMENTE, CALIFORNIA, ADOPTING A REVISED SALARY SCHEDULE AND NEW CLASSIFICATIONS AND AMENDING RESOLUTION NO. 97-09 AND ANY OTHER RESOLUTIONS IN CONFLICT THEREWITH

WHEREAS, Section 37206 of the Government Code requires the City Council to prescribe the time and method of paying salaries and wages of officers and employees of the City; and

WHEREAS, the City Council is authorized and directed under the provisions of its adopted Personnel Rules and Regulations to prepare the compensation schedules covering all classes of positions in the competitive service; and

WHEREAS, the City's classification/compensation resolution needs to be amended to eliminate one Sr. Utility Billing Specialist (1.0 FTE) position and add one Utility Billing Coordinator position (1.0 FTE); delete one Information Systems Technician (1.0 FTE) position and create a Technical Applications Specialist classification at salary Grade 47 and authorize one (1.0 FTE) position; create a Code Compliance Supervisor classification at salary Grade 56 and authorize one (1.0 FTE) position; and assign salary Grade 37 for the flexibly-staffed Accounting Specialist II classification.

NOW, THEREFORE, The City Council of the City of San Clemente does hereby resolve as follows:

Section 1. Resolution No. 97-09 is hereby amended by to add one (1.0 FTE) Sr. Utility Billing Coordinator position at Range 42 (\$3,993-\$4,853/month); add one (1.0 FTE) Technical Applications Specialist position at Range 47 (\$4,510-\$5,481/month) and approve a new job description; add one (1.0 FTE) Code Compliance Supervisor position at Range 56 (\$5,618-\$6,829/month) and approve a new job description; and place the Accounting Specialist II classification at Range 37 (\$3,533-\$4,295/month).

Section 2. The amended and restated All Employees salary schedule, dated June 19, 2012, with an effective date of July 1, 2012, which is on file in the City Clerk's Office, is hereby approved.
