



A Community Emergency Response Team (CERT) is a ready group of organized and trained volunteer disaster workers. The City of San Clemente offers CERT training to its residents and businesses twice a year.

The CERT Program consists of 20 hours of classroom and hands-on training and concludes with an exercise drill to apply the skills and knowledge obtained during the classroom sessions. Training includes the following subjects:

- Disaster Preparedness
- Fire Safety
- Disaster Medical Operations
- Light Search and Rescue
- CERT Organization
- Disaster Psychology
- CERT and Terrorism

Graduates of the program will have the opportunity to join the City of San Clemente CERT. When disaster strikes, CERT volunteers take action by:

- Checking on neighbors
- Suppressing small fires
- Conducting light urban search and rescue
- Providing emergency first aid and comfort
- Helping to organize and direct spontaneous volunteers
