## ORDINANCE NO.

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN CLEMENTE, CALIFORNIA, AMENDING THE REGIONAL CIRCULATION, FINANCING AND PHASING PROGRAM (RCFPP)

WHEREAS, the City of San Clemente Centennial General Plan, all City of San Clemente Specific Plans, and the Zoning Ordinance of the City of San Clemente establish limitations on land use which occurs in the City; and

WHEREAS, the primary goal of the City of San Clemente Centennial General Plan is to create a comprehensive, multimodal transportation system that provides all users with safe connections to homes, commercial centers, job centers, schools, community centers, open spaces, recreation areas and visitor destinations; and

WHEREAS, it is the policy of the City to maintain a Level of Service "D" or better at all intersections, except where flexibility is warranted based on a multi-modal Level of Service evaluation or where Level of Service E is deemed appropriate to accommodate complete streets facilities; and

WHEREAS, it is the policy of the City, during the design, construction or significant modification of major roadways, to promote scenic parkways or corridors to improve the City's visual quality and character, enhance adjacent uses, and integrate roadways with surrounding districts via features such as median planters, parkway plantings, and others as identified in the Centennial General Plan; and:

WHEREAS, the City of San Clemente Centennial General Plan identifies major and minor scenic corridors, and requires proper design, installation and maintenance of scenic corridor elements so that that such scenic corridors are maintained and preserved:

WHEREAS, without the planned, phased implementation of both circulation improvements and the County of Orange regional road network, development within the City would cause many roads and intersections within the City to exceed the acceptable Level of Service; and

WHEREAS, on April 5, 1989, the City Council adopted Ordinance No. 998 approving the Regional Circulation Financing and Phasing Program ("RCFPP") which (i) identifies roadways and their associated improvements which will have to be modified or constructed as new development occurs, (ii) provides a mechanism for funding the construction of those necessary roadways and their associated improvements, (iii) requires phasing that construction such that future development within the City does not

cause the city's traffic circulation system to operate at an unacceptable level of service, and (iv) establishes the authority for adoption of an implementing traffic impact fee; and

WHEREAS, on July 19, 1995, the City Council adopted Ordinance No. 1155 approving the 1995 RCFPP Amendment allowing development agreements to address the timing and amounts of RCFPP payments and combining traffic impact fee proceeds into a single account; and

WHEREAS, on December 20, 1997, the City Council adopted Ordinance No. 1196 approving the 1997 RCFPP Amendment updating the list of RCFPP improvement projects and amending the traffic impact fee; and

WHEREAS, the 2014 RCFPP Amendment is limited to updating the list of RCFPP eligible projects, and does not make any changes to the existing traffic impact fee methodology or rate; and

WHEREAS, in order to implement the 2014 RCFPP Amendment, it is necessary for the City Council to adopt this Ordinance to amend Section E of the 1997 RCFPP Amendment to update the list of RCFPP projects; and

WHEREAS, the adoption of this Ordinance is exempt from the provisions of the California Environmental Quality Act pursuant to California Public Resources Code Section 21080(b) (8) and Title 14, California Administrative Code, Section 15273.

**NOW, THEREFORE**, the City Council of the City of San Clemente, California, hereby ordains as follows:

<u>Section 1</u>: The City Council desires to amend Section E of the 1997 RCFPP Amendment to update the list of RCFPP projects as identified in the attached Exhibit A.

<u>Section 2:</u> Except as expressly set forth herein, Ordinance Nos. 998, 1155 and 1196 shall remain in full force and effect.

<u>Section 3:</u> The City Clerk shall certify to the passage of this ordinance and cause the same to be published as required by law, and the same shall take effect as provided by law.
