David Keehn, Orange County Fire Authority Chaplain, Battalion 6, gave the invocation.

2. ORAL COMMUNICATIONS (PART 1)

City Transparency

<u>Brad Malamud</u>, San Clemente, stated that the City is not transparent, noting that 10 years of historical records were removed from the City website; asserted that City officials have declined to meet with him; opined that the City defends lawsuits instead of seeking resolution.

San Clemente Campus of Saddleback Memorial Hospital (Potential Closure)

<u>Dr. Lawrence Chang</u>, San Clemente, stated that he serves as a physician to the senior population, noting that his patients are concerned about the potential closure of San Clemente Hospital; opined that access to specialized healthcare has always been geographically difficult in San Clemente and will be even more difficult with the closure of the hospital; spoke in support of finding an entity that will support a world-class hospital in San Clemente.

<u>Pete Curran</u>, San Clemente, opined that statistics provided by Saddleback Memorial Hospital are misleading and asserted that, in actuality, 82% of ambulance patients were transported to San Clemente Hospital during 2013 and 2014.

<u>Dr. Steve Cullen</u>, San Clemente, stated that 19 hospitals in Orange County were recently closed to paramedic units because they were at capacity; noted that the Intensive Care Unit at San Clemente Hospital is limited to only three patients.

<u>Warren Vidrine</u>, San Clemente, reported that he is trying to obtain a map of the hospital property to enable him to determine whether the hospital can be re-built in phases without impacting service.

North Beach/El Camino Real Parking Lot

<u>Ricardo Nicol</u>, San Clemente, expressed safety concerns with the proposed design of the North Beach/ El Camino Real parking lot; asserted that the current proposal contains excessive hardscape; urged Council to rescind its previous approval of the current parking lot design. A hard copy of Mr. Nicol's PowerPoint is on file in the City Clerk Department.

<u>Vonne Barnes</u>, San Clemente, urged Council to approve Mr. Nicol's proposed design for the North Beach/El Camino Real parking lot because it would preserve ocean views. A hard copy of Ms. Barnes' PowerPoint is on file with the City Clerk.

<u>Tom Barnes</u>, San Clemente, narrated a PowerPoint presentation which identified differences between the proposed plan and Mr. Nicol's alternate design for the North Beach/El Camino Real parking lot; spoke in support of the alternate plan; opined that the current design violates the California Coastal Act because it negatively affects ocean views. A hard copy of the PowerPoint is on file in the City Clerk Department.
