Subject:

ZONING AMENDMENT INITIATION – COMMERCIAL MASCOTS

Fiscal Impact: None.

Summary:

Staff recommends the City Council initiate a Zoning Amendment to prohibit the use of

commercial mascots as advertising.

Background:

The Zoning Ordinance does not address commercial mascots. Commercial mascots are a form of advertising in which a person or animal often stands in a visible location, dressed in a costume or distinctive colors that are closely associated with a business or organization. Commercial mascots often direct traffic to businesses by pointing or

waving.

Discussion:

Commercial mascots are inconsistent with the City's goals for signage because: 1) mascots can distract traffic which is a safety concern and may cause traffic delays; and 2) mascots can cause "sign clutter" and focus attention away from building signage, which is encouraged and commonly relied upon to identify businesses. To avoid these issues, staff recommends the City Council initiate an amendment to prohibit commercial mascots. The tentative timeline for this project is a Planning Commission meeting in April and City Council meeting in June.
