A. <u>Downtown Paseo Plan</u> (Jones)

The City of San Clemente prepared a draft Downtown Paseo Plan that will guide future public improvements in San Clemente's downtown alleys and will provide examples of potential private property improvements for properties fronting alleys. The Plan was developed with input from City staff, downtown merchants and property owners, the Downtown Business Association, and the general public. The purpose of this meeting is to present the Plan to the Planning Commission who will be making recommendations on the Plan to the City Council. The Plan is expected to guide future public and private property improvements related to lighting, surface treatment, landscape, trash and storage areas, loading facilities, and signage along downtown alleys.
