A. Discussion of potential to add new set of forward tees

## B. Discussion of potential capital projects for FY 2017

Staff and Committee Members continued discussion regarding potential capital improvement projects for fiscal year 2017, including:

• #16 restroom replacement;

- Putting green renovation;
- Potential of adding a putting green near hole #18;
- Renovating driving range turf; and
- Cart path on #17.

<u>Vinnie Poncino</u>, Head Golf Professional, opined the turf in the front area of the driving range area should be considered as a capital project.

## C. <u>Discussion of USGA visit 10-5-15 and report</u>

Golf Manager Nelson presented a report from USGA from the recent visit on 10/5/15 and discussed corrective actions to be taken on the #5 green.

## 5. **NEW BUSINESS**

## A. Proposal to implement 90 degree rule for golf carts on course

Committee Members discussed the potential implementation of a 90 degree rule for golf carts on the course, and other measures that may reduce cart damage to greens.

Consensus was reached to implement outreach to players to suggest a 90 degree rule be followed during the winter season.
