GRANT FUNDING APPLICATION TO CALIFORNIA DIVISION OF BOATING AND WATERWAYS.

Fiscal Impact: Yes. Receipt of this grant will reduce the City's cost sharing contribution for the construction of the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers sand replenishment project to about

\$600,000.

Summary:

This action is to formally approve, by resolution, an initial grant application submitted

by staff to the California Division of Boating and Waterways for funding assistance

with the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers beach sand replenishment project.

Discussion:

The U.S. Army Corps of Engineers received congressional authorization for a sand replenishment project on the City's beach between Linda Lane and south T-Street beaches. The estimated cost of the initial sand placement is about \$11 million, with the City's required cost sharing contribution estimated at about \$4 million. Staff submitted an initial application to the California Division of Boating and Waterways under its Public Beach Restoration program for grant funding to help the City provide the required local cost sharing contribution. The application requested \$3.4 million which is the maximum grant funding that could be provided subject to State funding availability. The grant program rules require submittal of a resolution by the City Council before March 31, 2016 to ratify the grant funding application. If the City receives the full grant amount, the City's remaining share of the required cost sharing contribution would be reduced to about \$600,000.

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## RESOLUTION NO.

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN CLEMENTE, CALIFORNIA, APPROVING THE APPLICATION FOR GRANT FUNDS UNDER THE CALIFORNIA DIVISION OF BOATING AND WATERWAYS PUBLIC BEACH RESTORATION PROGRAM FOR CONSTRUCTION OF THE U.S. ARMY CORPS OF ENGINEERS BEACH SAND REPLENISHMENT PROJECT.

WHEREAS, the mission of the California Division of Boating and Waterways' Public Beach Restoration Program is to preserve and protect the California coastline by restoring and maintaining natural and recreational resources and minimizing damages by natural or man-made induced beach erosion; and

WHEREAS, the City of San Clemente has suffered severe beach sand loss in recent years, which has resulted in the loss of recreational beach, damages to or destruction of beachfront facilities and increased risk to beach patrons due to the exposure of underlying hard structures; and

WHEREAS, the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers completed a Feasibility Study and received congressional authorization for a sand replenishment project on a portion of the City's beach; and

WHEREAS, the estimated cost of the approved sand replenishment project is about \$11 million, with the City of San Clemente's local cost sharing contribution estimated at about \$4 million; and

WHEREAS, the City of San Clemente wishes to submit an application to the State of California, Department of Parks and Recreation, Division of Boating and Waterways for grant funding to assist the City with its local cost sharing requirement for construction of the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers sand replenishment project.

NOW, THEREFORE, The City Council of the City of San Clemente does hereby resolve as follows:

<u>Section 1.</u> The City Council approves the filing of a grant application for funding for construction of the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers' Beach Sand Replenishment Project, under and pursuant to the terms and provisions of the California Division of Boating and Waterways' Public Beach Restoration Program.

Section 2. The City Manager is authorized to act as the representative of the City of San Clemente and to sign and submit the grant funding application, as well as to negotiate and execute all agreements necessary to comply with the California Division of Boating and Waterways' grant program requirements.

Section 3. The City Clerk shall certify to the passage and adoption of this resolution and enter it into the book of original resolutions.
