

Permanent Year-Round Restrictions on Water Waste



Some Requirements for City of San Clemente water customers:

- ❖ Outdoor watering is prohibited between 9:00 a.m. and 6:00 p.m., except as provided below:
 - ❖ Watering is permitted during these hours, if done by hand using a hose with an automatic shutoff nozzle, or if by drip irrigation.
- ❖ Washing down hard or paved surfaces is prohibited (sidewalks, driveways, etc.).
- ❖ It is prohibited to allow landscaping to be watered while it is raining.
- ❖ Overspray and runoff is prohibited.
- ❖ Hoses must be equipped with an automatic shutoff nozzle to wash vehicles.
- ❖ Food and beverage service facilities shall not serve water to customers except upon request by the customers.
- ❖ Turf grass (lawn) shall no longer be installed on medians, parkways, island dividers, on other non-recreational areas, in areas fewer than eight (8) feet in width, or on slopes greater than 20% for any new, rehabilitated, or re-landscaped project.
