A. <u>120 Avenida Algodon – Amendment to Cultural Heritage Permit 16-307–</u> Jones Addition (Carrillo)

Public Hearing to consider a request to modify the previously approved Cultural Heritage Permit for an additional to a legal non-conforming historic home. The project is located at 120 Avenida Algodon in the Residential Medium (RM) zoning

district. The site's legal description is Lot 21, of Tract 779, Assessor's Parcel Number 058-093-08.

Based on the information in the staff report and subject to the required Findings and Conditions of Approval, staff recommends that the Planning Commission:

- 1. Determine the project is Categorically Exempt from the requirements of the California Environmental Quality Act pursuant to CEQA Guidelines Section 15301 and direct staff to file a Notice of Exemption.
- 2. Approve Cultural Heritage Permit 16-307 subject to attached Resolution 17-012 and conditions of approval.

B. <u>Cultural Heritage Permit 16-354 – 508 Victoria Duplex</u> (Schuller)

Public Hearing to consider a request to demolish an existing residential fourplex and to construct a residential duplex on a site located at 508 Avenida Victoria in the Residential High zone of the Pier Bowl Specific Plan and within the Architectural Overlay (PBSP-RH-A).

Based on the information in the staff report and subject to the required Findings and Conditions of Approval, staff recommends that the Planning Commission:

- 1. Determine the project is Categorically Exempt from the requirements of the California Environmental Quality Act pursuant to CEQA Guidelines Section 15303(b); and direct staff to file a Notice of Exemption.
- 2. Approve Cultural Heritage Permit 16-354, subject to attached Resolution 17-011 and conditions of approval.
