Public Hearing to consider an appeal that was filed with the City of San Clemente appealing the decision rendered in an Administrative Hearing of a City-initiated STLU Operating License Revocation Hearing for the property located at 305 West Avenida Gaviota.

# Staff Recommendation

Revoke STLU Operating License 314801, due to the extraordinary number of complaints received by the City, which the City continues to receive, related to nuisances created by the STLU, the continual demonstration of the STLU permittee to operate the property in a manner that does not maintain the character of the residential neighborhood, and the disproportionately high amount of time City Staff and the Orange County Sheriff's Department have spent responding to the nuisances and disturbances caused by this STLU. Furthermore, the property has not complied with the conditions imposed by the Administrative Hearing Officer, nor appears to have made any attempt to modify the STLU's operating standards to reduce nuisances when notified of them.
