DECLARATION OF SURPLUS AND DISPOSITION OF RETIRED EQUIPMENT.

Fiscal Impact: Yes, but the amount is undetermined at this time. Net proceeds from the auction and sale of the surplus equipment will be placed into the Sewer and Water Operating Funds and recognized as revenue into Accounts 052-000-39110 and 054-000-39110 as listed on the Attachment. The cost for the auction services are deducted from the gross proceeds of the sale of the equipment.

Summary:

Declare the City of San Clemente equipment listed on the Attachment as surplus authorize the services of Ken Porter Auctions for the disposal of the surplus equipment.

Background/ Discussion:

The Utilities Division periodically retires equipment that has been replaced or is obsolete. The equipment recommended for surplus in the Attachment no longer meets regulatory air quality requirements and can not be used or sold in California. There are potential uses and resale value in other states or countries. There are three emergency pumps and four emergency electrical generators that meet this criteria. The majority of the equipment has been replaced and the retired units have accumulated at the Water Reclamation Plant and are awaiting proper disposal,

The City utilizes a third-party auction company to list, sell, and complete all necessary documentation to transfer ownership of the retired equipment. Proceeds from the sale of surplus equipment will be placed into the Water and Sewer Operating Funds to offset future replacement expenses.

Recommended

Action:

STAFF RECOMMENDS THAT the City Council declare the equipment identified on the Attachment as surplus and approve and authorize Ken Porter Auctions for the public auctioning of the City of San Clemente surplus equipment as listed on the Attachment.
