Letter from the City Manager

San Clemente just keeps getting better all the time. The month of August kicked off with a grand opening of a new public park, Pico Park located at 315 Avenida Pico. Let the energy of San Clemente's kids spill over into this new park! On August 3rd, Mayor Baker cut the ribbon to officially designate this beautiful new park—just the first of 4 public parks that will be accessible to the public at Sea Summit.

Pico Park is adjacent to the Sea Summit trail system and provides direct access to the trail. The many amenities include the much anticipated basketball court with sport court lights, parking lot, ADA accessible, BBQs, hot coal dispensers, children's playground for ages 2-5 & ages 5-12, covered picnic pavilion, picnic table, benches, trash and recycle bins, restrooms, drinking fountain, pathway lights, interpretive signage, California native landscaping and turf grass, and recycled water irrigation.

There's another grand opening event to come this month with the completion of the La Pata Gap Connector project. Come join the cities of San Clemente and San Juan Capistrano and the County of Orange to celebrate this accomplishment which has been on the County General Plan since the 1960's. On Saturday, August 13, 2016 from 10:00 a.m. to 2:00 p.m., a Ribbon Cutting Celebration and community event is planned and all are welcome.

This family-friendly event will include a car show with upwards of 100 classic cars, seven food trucks, live music, information booths, and a ribbon cutting ceremony to commemorate the new 2.2-mile roadway, which will provide easier access to area retail centers, an alternative route for emergency and public safety needs, as well as an easier commute to local schools and other destinations. Event access from San Clemente is on Avenida La Pata at Calle Saluda in the Talega area.
