# A. Potential Future Agenda Items

Supervisor Mallett reviewed the status of Potential Future Agenda Items and requested the Committee Members provide input.

Committee Members requested staff add "Beaches, Parks and Recreation Master Plan Discussion" to the January agenda.

Supervisor Mallett agreed to arrange for transportation to the Anaerobic Digester Tour on February 22, 2018, in Perris, CA from 9:00 a.m. to12:00 p.m. for those interested in attending. She will email all with additional information on the event. Additionally, she is organizing a field trip to Poche Beach for the CAC Members, and have access to the Poche Clean Beach project (UV Plant), with attendance by the new OC Engineer assigned to the Plant, and potentially a demonstration by the Falconer. She speculated February may be the best month for the field trip, and will email them with potential dates.

## 10. ITEMS FROM COMMITTEE MEMBERS

Committee Member Ayer reported that at its last meeting, the Beaches, Parks and Recreation Commission were presented with an update on the Draft Master Plan.

Chair Ambrose commented that the Draft Master Plan does not address beach issues, and the Committee discussed importance of having that information in the Master Plan as well as potential for the CAC to participate by providing input. She recommended all CAC Members read the Draft Master Plan and be prepared for discussion at their January meeting.

Committee Member Campopiano announced the State of California has released its draft update regarding sea level rise guidance and the public comment period is open. She agreed to forward the document to Supervisor Mallett for forwarding to the CAC Members.

Committee Member Smith commented that he is working on a presentation featuring the many beaches he has visited during travels and will screen the presentation for them when it's ready; requested information on the Shorecliffs Via Ballena Storm Drain project. Supervisor Mallett agreed to gather information requested and report back.

Chair Ambrose announced information on the City's pier netting plan is available on the Government TV access channel; announced City Planner Gregg attended the California Coastal Commission meeting regarding the Local Coastal Plan and will follow up with a report.
