



The CERT Program is designed to train citizens to organize their families and neighborhoods and be more prepared to react to emergencies. CERT trainings are offered to its residents and businesses yearly.

The CERT Program consists of 20 hours (six weekday evenings and one Saturday morning) of classroom and hands-on training that concludes with an exercise drill to apply the skills and knowledge obtained during the classroom sessions.
