One membership is the social membership which includes services like rides, going to doctor's appointments, getting hair done, or getting grocery shopping done. The other type of membership is a full membership. The non-profit organization is constantly looking for volunteers who go through a thorough background check, and look forward to creating an age friendly community. The organization is looking for special deals or free storage space.
