The Public Hearing process includes a staff presentation, a presentation by the applicant not to exceed ten (10) minutes, and public testimony. To facilitate the meeting for all attendees, the public is asked to limit their individual presentation to three (3) minutes. Following closure of the Public Hearing, the Planning Commission will respond to questions raised during the hearing, discuss the issues, and act upon the matter by motion.

### A. <u>Zoning Amendment (ZA) 18-497 – Regulation of Leaf Blowers</u> (Stonich)

A City-initiated zoning amendment for regulation of leaf blowers. The proposed code amendment will incorporate limitations on the use of leaf blowers in the City of San Clemente Municipal Code Title 8: Chapter 8.48, Noise Control and Chapter 8.64.190, Leaf Blower Operation.

Staff recommends the project be found exempt from CEQA because the adoption of the proposed ordinance is not a project within the meaning of the term set forth in State CEQA Guidelines, section 15378(a) and 15061(b). Staff further recommends that the project be found categorically exempt from the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) pursuant to State CEQA Guidelines Sections 15307 (Class 7) Actions by Regulatory Agencies for Protection of Natural Resources and 15308 (Class 8): Actions by Regulatory Agencies for Protection of the Environment.

### B. <u>709 North El Camino Real – Conditional Use Permit 18-574 – Terra Brazil Convenience Store</u> (Morones)

A request to consider a convenience store in an existing multitenant building located in the Neighborhood Commercial 1.2 Zone and Coastal Zone and Affordable Housing Overlays.

Staff recommends the project be found categorically exempt from the requirements of the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) pursuant to State CEQA Guidelines Section 15303 (Class 3) because the proposed project involves the conversion of an existing structure from one use to another.

## C. <u>203 La Paloma – Cultural Heritage Permit 18-051/Tentative Parcel Map 18-081 – La Paloma Triplex</u> (Lightfoot)

A request to consider a three unit development on a vacant lot in the Residential Medium Zone within the Coastal Overlay (RM-CZ) and within 300 feet of historic properties. The proposal also includes the subdivision of air space to allow for individual sale of the proposed condominium units.

Staff recommends the project be found categorically exempt from the requirements of the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) pursuant to State CEQA Guidelines Section 15303(a) (Class 3: New Construction or Conversion of Small Structures) and Section 15315 (Class 15: Minor Land Divisions). The project is categorically exempt because it involves the construction of a multi-family residential structure, totaling no more than four dwelling units, and the proposed subdivision occurs in an urbanized area zoned for residential use.
