Subject: Initiation of Specific Plan Amendment – Public Safety Uses in the Rancho San

CLEMENTE SPECIFIC PLAN

Fiscal Impact: Initiating this Specific Plan Amendment would not, in itself, result in a fiscal impact.

However, if initiated, the amendment would require the expenditure of funds to ensure compliance with the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA). The amount of that expenditure is unknown at this time. If the environmental review requires an allocation of funds from the General Fund, staff may return to City Council to make the request.

Background: On June 18, 2019, the City Council approved amendments to Ordinance Nos. 1673

and 1674 allowing interim limited camping at the City public works yard on Avenida Pico. The amendments established an expiration date of June 30, 2020. Thereafter, public camping on City property, as permitted by Ordinance Nos. 1673 and 1674, will no longer be permitted by special exception to the Municipal Code. In connection with those enactments, the City Council requested staff to explore additional options for

locating an interim camping site elsewhere in the City.

Discussion: The City owns several properties in the light and heavy industrial planning areas of

Rancho San Clemente that may serve as options for locating an interim camping site. The Rancho San Clemente Specific Plan permits a range of nonresidential land uses, including business park, industrial park, and commercial uses. The Specific Plan currently allows public safety uses in the Institutional zone. The proposed initiation would consider adding public safety uses as an allowed use in the Industrial Park zone. The goal of such an amendment would be to provide the City with more discretion and regulatory flexibility to address issues that adversely affect the public health, safety and welfare. Although "public safety uses" are not defined in the Specific Plan, this could include temporary public camping or a police substation, when

authorized by the City.

Environmental

Review: The initiation of an amendment would not, in itself, in any way impact or alter the

physical environment. Accordingly, this action is exempt from environmental review under State CEQA Guidelines, Section 15061(b)(3), the General Rule Exemption.

Recommended

Action: STAFF RECOMMENDS THAT the City Council initiate a Specific Plan Amendment, as

authorized by Municipal Code Section 17.16.030(D), to amend the Rancho San

Clemente Specific Plan and add public safety uses as a permitted use in the Industrial

Park zone.
