

Community Safety Plan Standard Operating Procedures

Purpose:

To ensure guest safety, security, and success. Violation of this plan can cause you to be cited, arrested, or evicted.

Registration:

All campers will be required to check-in and register with the on-site security guard upon their first arrival to the site. Individuals wishing to camp and reserve a space must provide their name and last location of residence. Any guests to the site must also check-in and provide their name to the security guard.

Area Hours:

Quiet time will be enforced from 10 pm to 7 am. No visitors will be allowed during the quiet hours.

Items Not Allowed:

The following items are not allowed on the property and will be confiscated:

- Weapons of any kind
- Alcohol
- Drugs or drug paraphernalia
- Illegal substances of any kind
- Medication(s) that are not prescribed to you
- EZ ups, "lean-tos", or pop-up shelters beyond the provided city-owned tent

The following items are not allowed on the property and can be held by security:

• Dangerous tools or personal item(s)

Illegal Behaviors:

The following behaviors are not permitted:

- Violence, harassment, bullying or threatening behavior of any kind towards others
- Possession or use of drugs, alcohol, or illegal substances
- Sharing legal or illegal drugs or medications with another person
- Theft of property
- Defacing, destroying, or damaging property or property in the surrounding area
- No open flames or flammable items
- Loud music or other disruptive noise

Engaging in behavior on or near the property that may negatively affect the peace and
enjoyment of the property and surrounding property for other overnight sleepers or for
neighbors in the nearby area

Site Provisions:

The following will be applied:

- Designated camping spaces are for tent camping only.
- Spaces are reserved for 1 camper per space.
- Tents may only be erected between the hours of 5 pm and 10 am, daily.
- No affixing tarps or shade covers to city-owned property.
- Campers must keep their property within their designated space.
- Any personal property beyond what can fit in a camper's designated space, will be removed and stored by the City until the camper is no longer living at the camp or in the City.
- Bicycles will be permitted and limited to 1 per camper. Any additional bicycles will be stored offsite by the City.
