A. <u>Small Cell Regulations</u> (Crockett)

In preparation for the Commission's review of the Draft Small Cell Ordinance (ZA 19-189), Katie Crockett, Associate Planner, and the City Attorney's office will provide an overview of state and federal regulations that limit the City's discretion over small wireless telecommunications facilities ("small cells") and new regulations that necessitate modification to the City review of small cell applications.

Associate Planner Crockett reviewed the Ordinance review process and anticipated timeline.

Andrew McCardle, Attorney, Best, Best & Krieger, LLP, narrated a PowerPoint Presentation entitled, "Small Cells, Planning Commission Study Session, Small Wireless Facility Regulations," dated October 16, 2019. A copy of the Presentation

is on file in Planning Division. He reviewed key provisions of Federal and State Law that govern the placement of Small Wireless Facilities throughout all California cities; noted local jurisdictions have some regulation over placement and aesthetics as long as these regulations do not conflict with the limits imposed by State and Federal Laws.

Associate Planner Crockett advised the City will be scheduling a public workshop, potentially at the Commission's second meeting in November. She encouraged them to visit the City's website to access additional information, and agreed to email a copy of tonight's Presentation to them directly.
