Prior Informal Scoping Effort

- Community outreach began in 2016
- Conducted public meetings and agency workshops
- 21 ideas reduced to 8
- 2 additional ideas added since the PSR
- These 10 + "No-Build" ideas are the "starting point" for the current process

Formal Process

- Notice of Intent to Prepare an EIS (NEPA)
- Notice of Preparation of an EIR (CEQA)
- What does this mean?
 - Marks the beginning of scoping period
 - Officially Notifies public/agencies of scoping period
 - Invites comments on purpose and need and the alternatives
 - Broadly circulated notice

Where We are Today/Next Steps

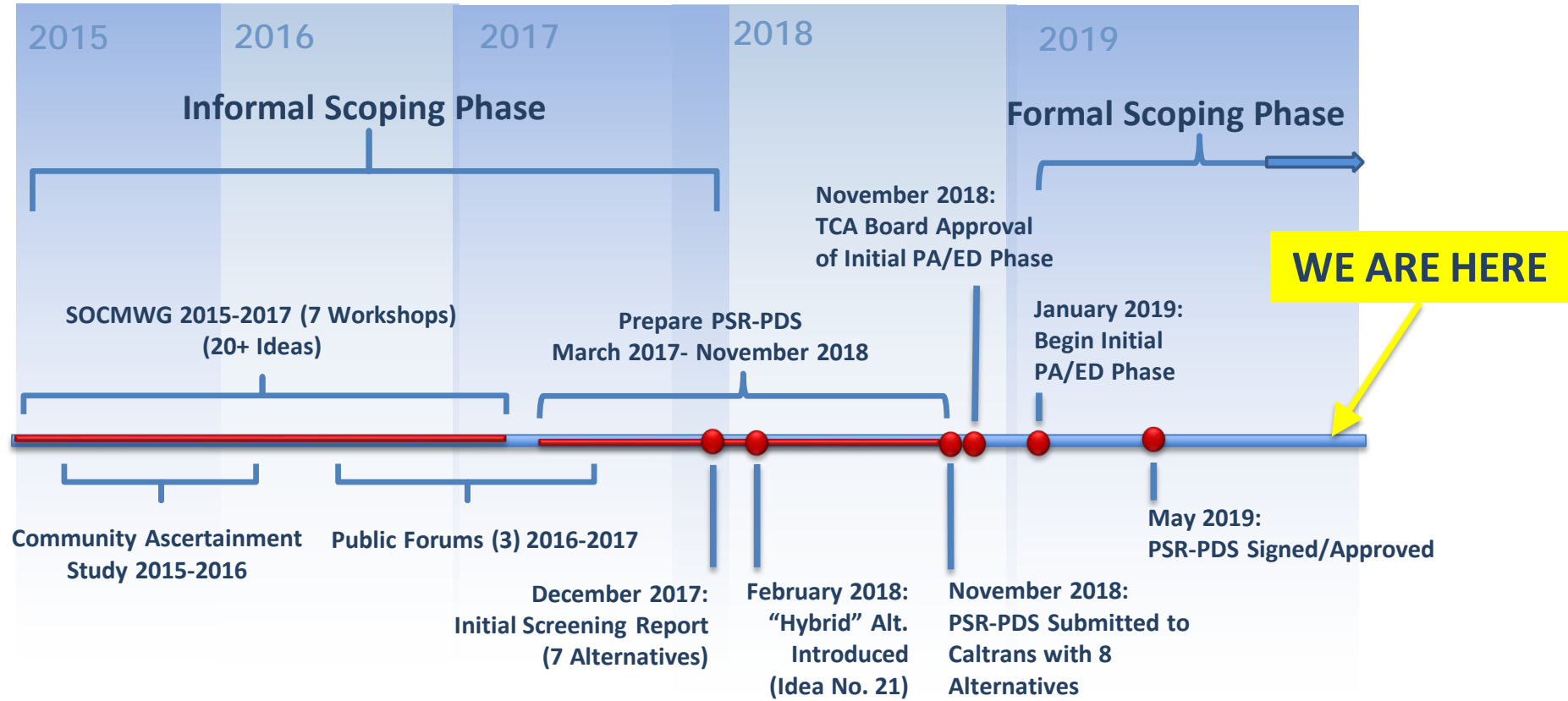
- Public Scoping Period (Nov. 8th – Dec. 9th)
 - Host open house format public meetings:
 - Wed., Nov. 20 from 5 to 8 p.m. in Mission Viejo
 - Wed., Dec. 4 from 5 to 8 p.m. in Dana Point
 - Request formal public input on the 10 + “No-Build” ideas
 - Refine purpose and need and the alternatives:
 - January – April 2020

- Southern Study Area
 - Dana Point – The Ocean Institute

 - Introduction video



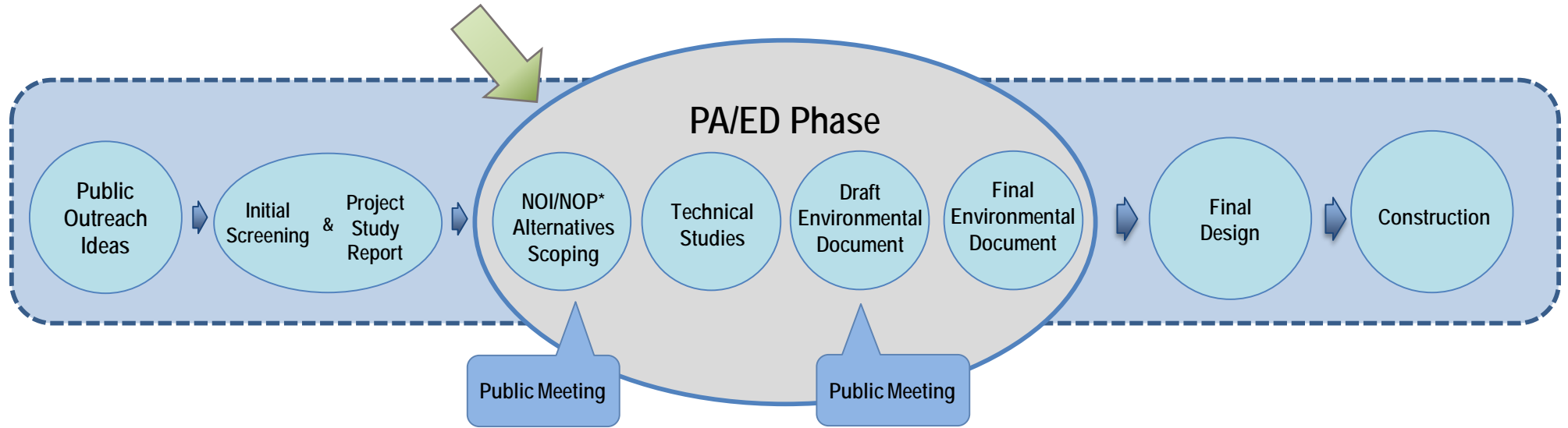
