

NOVEMBER 2019 HOMELESS STATISTICS

The number of people sleeping on the streets and in public places in Orange County has grown exponentially in recent years, affecting local residents, businesses and people experiencing homelessness. The City of San Clemente understands the need to coordinate resources to provide services to people and families experiencing homelessness in our community. As such, the City of San Clemente has prioritized addressing the issue of homelessness.

The City is actively working with its partners at the County, the Orange County Sheriff's Department (OCSD), and various non-profits in the community to take a holistic approach to public safety and addressing the needs of those people in our city who are experiencing homelessness. The City is focused on outreach to assist the homeless population and provide them with access to available resources and services. To that end, the City is contracted with Mercy House to provide outreach services. The following are the monthly statistics associated with Mercy House's efforts:
