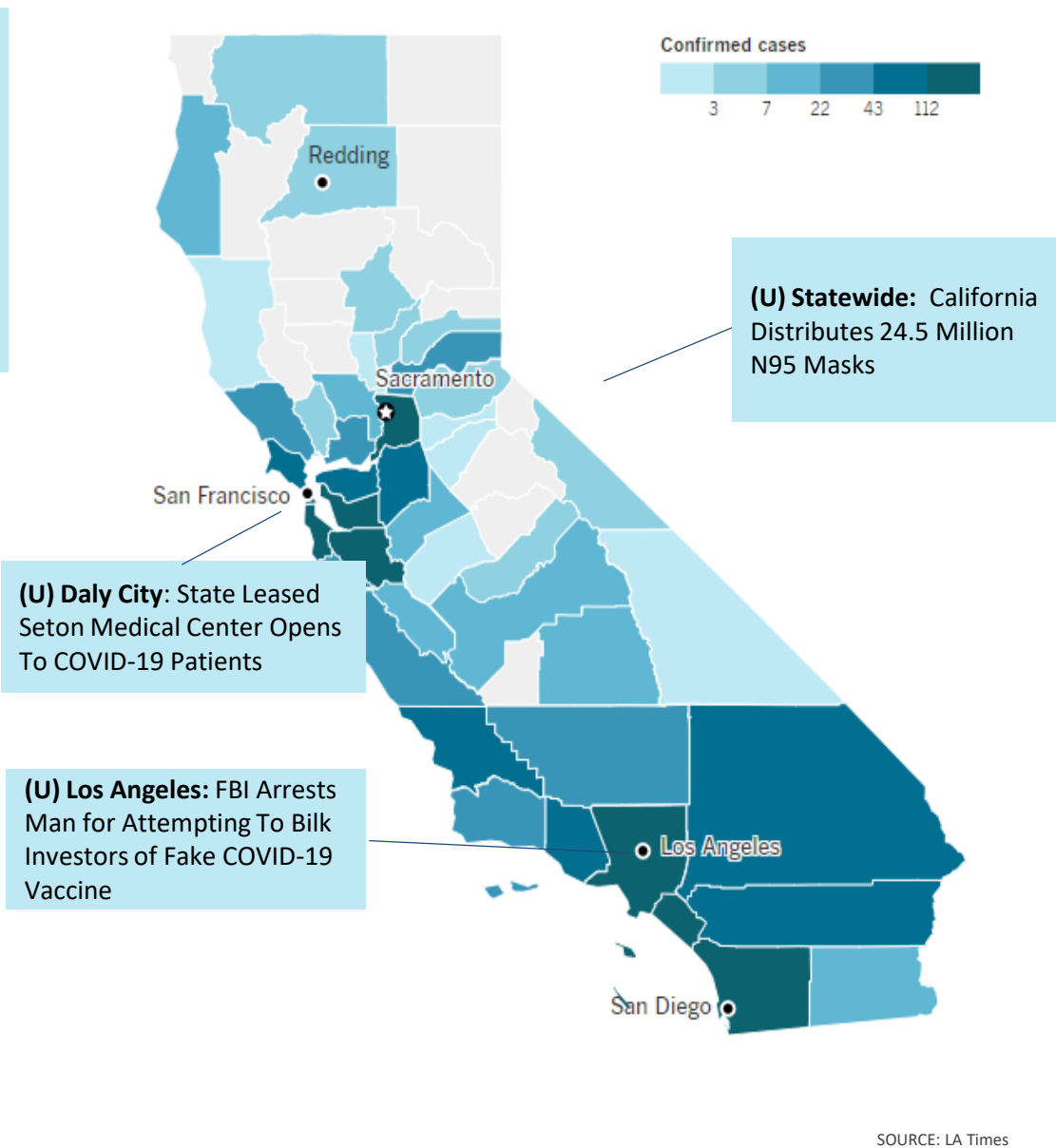
(U) CALIFORNIA IMPACTS: CORONAVIRUS DISEASE 2019 (COVID-19)

(U) As of 26 March, 65 deaths have been confirmed in California as a result of COVID-19 infections, as reported by the CDPH. The Governor and other state leaders continue to call on citizens to maintain social distancing standards. In the United States, the number of deaths increase to more than 1,000 in the United States and cases in two of the hardest hit states — California and New York — quickly multiply. Throughout the country American unemployment claims have peaked to nearly 3.3 million amid a widespread economic shutdown caused by the coronavirus, as the US Senate passed a \$2 trillion stimulus package to bolster the US economy. Globally, the number of cases has surpassed 500,000, with Italy reporting more than 6,000 new infections today, taking its total to over 80,000 cases and over 8,000 deaths.

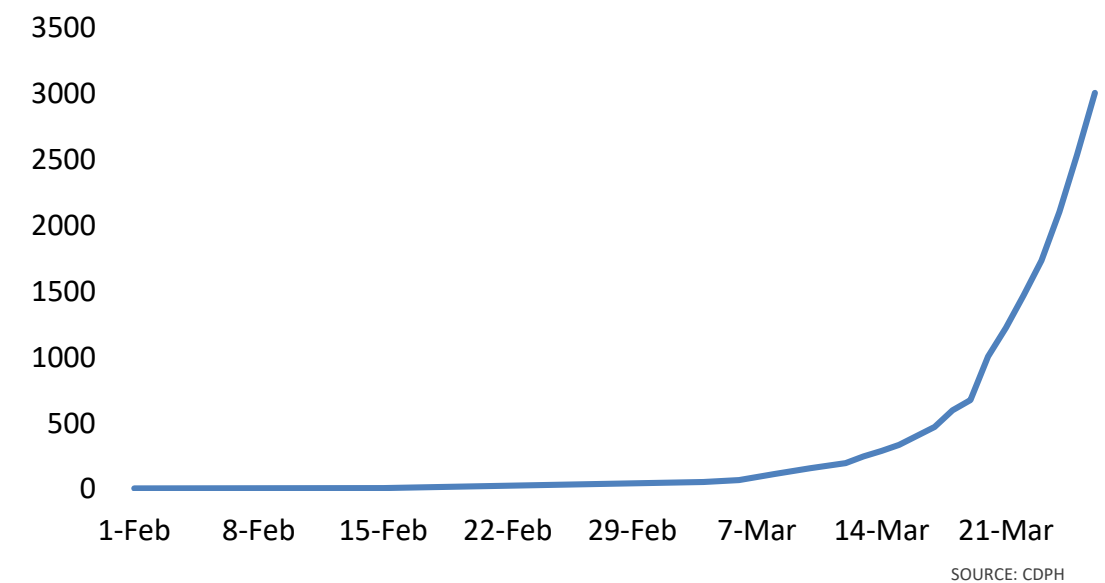

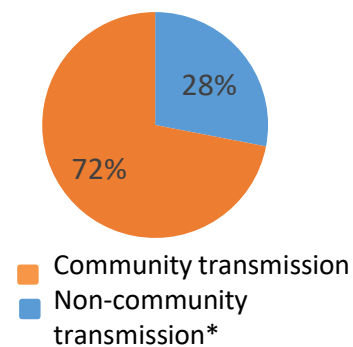

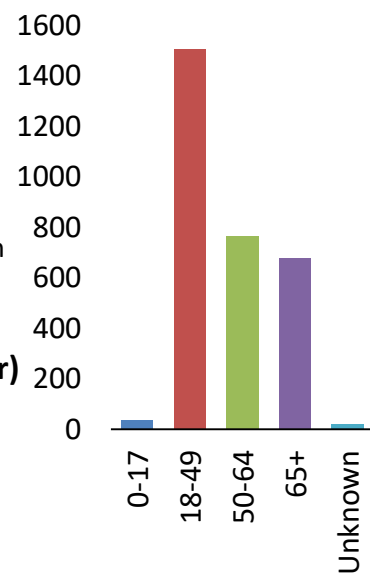
Cumulative Cases By Day (As of 26 March 2020)



California COVID-19 Infection Sources

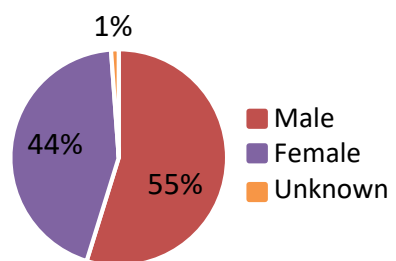


Confirmed Cases by Age Range
