A Special San Clemente City Council meeting was called to order on March 30, 2020 at 5:04 p.m. by Mayor Bane. This meeting was conducted via teleconference.

Closed Session Report

City Attorney Smith reported during this evening's Closed Session, Council took action to add text to the Resolution that will be discussed under Agenda Item 3-A. Additionally, City Attorney Smith announced that Council agreed to a potential amendment to the Settlement Agreement with Memorial Care; advised that Mayor Bane recused himself from the portion of the Closed Session relating to the Memorial Care issue because the law firm with which he is employed represents Memorial Care.

3. PUBLIC SESSION

A. Consideration of A Resolution of the City Council of the City of San Clemente, California, Supplementing the City Council's Proclamation of a Local Emergency Regarding Novel Coronavirus (COVID-19)

Deputy City Clerk Campagnolo read emails received from the public as follows:

Maura Mikulec, Capistrano Beach, urged that efforts be undertaken to protect the homeless population from the spread of COVID-19. A hard copy of Ms. Mikulec's email, dated March 30, 2020, is on file with the City Clerk.

<u>Jacky Trani</u>, San Clemente, urged Council to utilize emergency funding granted by Governor Newsom to provide shelter for homeless individuals. A hard copy of Ms. Trani's email, dated March 30, 2020, is on file with the City Clerk.

<u>Lisa and Rick Zimmerman</u>, Owners of kith & kin boutique, inquired whether the City is doing anything to aid small businesses during the COVID-19 crisis. A hard copy of the Zimmermans' email, dated March 30, 2020 is on file with the City Clerk.

<u>Vonne Barnes</u>, San Clemente, urged Council to contact all governmental agencies to expedite the opening of San Clemente Hospital. A hard copy of Ms. Barnes' email, dated March 30, 2020 is on file with the City Clerk.

During the ensuing discussion, Council and Staff responded to public inquiries relative to the following: 1) the County's plans to shelter homeless persons who are COVID-19 positive as well as those who are at-risk for COVID-19; and 2) resources available to assist small businesses during the pandemic.

Council requested that Staff prepare a Press Release to inform residents that San Clemente is a general law city and, as such, is duty bound to follow the laws of California, including direction being provided by the County Health Officer concerning COVID-19.

City Attorney Smith reviewed the contents of the Administrative Report and responded to Council inquiries.

MOTION BY MAYOR BANE, SECOND BY MAYOR PRO TEM FERGUSON, CARRIED 5-0, to adopt Resolution No. 20-24 entitled A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN CLEMENTE, CALIFORNIA, SUPPLEMENTING ITS PROCLAMATION OF A LOCAL EMERGENCY REGARDING NOVEL CORONAVIRUS (COVID-19), with the direction that the following verbiage be added to Section 4:

"Mobile testing for COVID-19 for residents with priority to 92673 and 92672 zip codes is permitted in the Regional Medical Facilities 1 (RMF1) Zone for the duration of this local emergency."
