STAGE 1: SAFETY AND PREPAREDNESS.

Based on guidance from the Governor's Office, the State of California is currently in Stage 1. This Stage seeks to make the essential workforce environment safe.

- Passive park space open with social distance measures
- Inland trails open
- Golf Course
 - Reservations and payment online only
 - Reduction in tee times
 - No carts, restrooms, shared course equipment, practice areas, or Pro Shop

STAGE 2: LOWER RISK WORKPLACES

Allows retail lower risk sectors to adapt and re-open. Modified school programs and childcare re-open.

- **Aquatics Facilities**
 - Lap Swim only (Ages 16+ years)
 - No spectators – “active use” only
 - Advanced reservation required (30-90 minute increments)
 - No Locker room use
 - No diving blocks
 - San Clemente Aquatics Team practices with restrictions
- **City Hall**
 - Public Counters open with modifications (appointment only)
 - Face masks required for entry to buildings
 - Installation of “sneeze guards”/safety partitions
 - Administrative Staff remain on split schedules/telecommuting
 - Operational Staff remain on split crew schedules
 - Maintenance Yard/Water Reclamation Plant remain closed to public
- **Community Center**
 - Public counter open with modifications – no rentals/classes
- **Day Camps (Beginning June 15)**
 - Temperature checks/health questions at check-in
 - Disinfect equipment between each use
 - Handwashing breaks every 30 minutes
- **Pickleball Courts**
 - Remain closed. USAPA suspending sanctioning of existing pickleball tournaments through May 14, 2020.
- **Playgrounds**
 - Closed, as recommended by National Recreation and Park Association (NRPA).
- **Skate Court**
 - Limit 10 users in court – staff monitored

- Bleachers closed
- **Tennis Courts**
 - Singles only
 - Gates locked open; benches unavailable for use

STAGE 3: HIGHER RISK WORKPLACES

Open higher risk environments with adaptations and limits on size of gatherings; Entertainment venues (movie theaters, sports without live audiences); In-person services (ie. weddings)

- **Aquatic Facilities**
 - Lap Swim (Stage 2 measures remain in place)
 - Recreation Swim with decreased capacity
 - Diving Boards Closed
 - Swim classes available, with limited class sizes
 - Deck markers, 6-ft.
 - Entry and exit pathways within pool
- **Ballfields/Sport Parks**
 - Permits issued for groups of 10 or less
 - Drop-in use permitted (no large groups gatherings)
 - Tournaments with modifications – no spectators
- **Basketball Courts**
 - Household gatherings only
 - No scrimmages
- **City Hall**
 - Stage 2 measures remain in place
 - Maintenance Yard/Building N opens to public
- **Community Center**
 - Private rentals permitted, max. 50 with physical distancing
- **Golf Course**
 - Stage 1 measures remain in place
 - Increase tee time availability
 - Evaluate practice facilities and pro shop ops based on OCHCA direction
- **Pickleball Courts**
 - Singles only
 - No waiting on courts; no chairs on courts
 - Queuing 6-feet apart out
- **Picnic Pavilions & Rentals**
 - One rental per day, limited rental size
- **Recreation Classes**
 - Class sizes decreased
 - Increased facility and equipment cleaning between classes
- **Senior Mobility Program**

- Currently providing rides to grocery stores only.
- Resume rides to Senior Center upon reopening
- **Tennis Courts**
 - Doubles allowed
- **Volleyball Courts**
 - Singles only

STAGE 4: END OF STAY-AT-HOME ORDER

All facilities open without restrictions. Hand sanitization stations remain available at all city facilities.

****Jr. Lifeguard Program:** 3 sessions with almost 300 kids each. Not possible to physical distance, wear masks, etc. Given lead time for tryouts and program ramp up, essentially means no JG program for this year

****SC Trolley:** Physical distancing will significantly reduce passenger capacity from 24 to 6, will not be cost effective to run until physical distancing not needed, or face coverings required. Still requires OCTA to relax ridership requirements otherwise grant funds will be at risk.
