

Theme Week: DINO MITE

Dinosaur Feet

Materials:

Empty tissue boxes (one for each foot)

Duct tape

Paint or decoupage materials

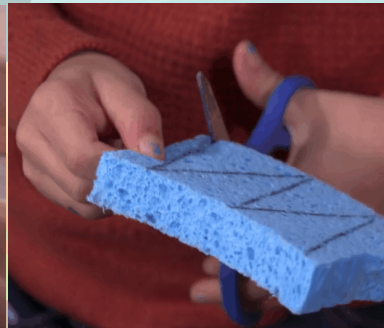
Scissors

Sponge, craft foam, or cardboard for toenails

Tacky glue or hot glue

Directions:

1. Before you begin the activity, look at pictures of dinosaur feet for inspiration for this project!
2. Take two empty tissue boxes. Use the duct tape to create the right size opening for each foot. This ensures that your child's foot fits inside without slipping and also reinforces the box.
3. Decorate by painting or gluing tissue paper to the boxes. Allow them to dry.
4. Once dry, cut triangles out of a sponge, craft foam, or cardboard. These will be the dinosaurs' toes.
5. Glue triangles to the front of each tissue box. Time to roam the house!
