Theme Week: DINO

Jurassic Volcano

Materials:

- Batch of salt dough (see Try-It Tuesday for recipe)
- Small plastic water bottle
- Paint
- Baking soda
- Vinegar
- Food coloring
- Dish soap (optional)



Instructions:

- Make a batch of salt dough. Directions and supplies you will need can be found on Try-It Tuesday: Acheology Dinosaur Fossil Dig!
- 2. Shape the salt dough into a volcano shape around the empty plastic water bottle. Depending on the size of the water bottle and the size of the volcano you might need to make 2 batches of salt dough and allow the volcano to dry for 24 hours.
- 3. Once your volcano is dry, paint and add your own personal Jurassic touches!
- 4. once your volcano is ready to erupt, you will need to prepare the eruption! To the opening add a tablespoon or 2 of baking soda, food coloring, and a squirt of dish soap.
- 5. Time for the volcano to erupt! Make sure your volcano is on a tray to catch the lava flow. Pour the vinegar into the opening and watch. The kiddos are going to want to do this one over and over again!
