## **BACKGROUND**

- Serve as Transportation Parking Committee
- Serve as the Cultural Heritage Board
- Serve as the Design Review Subcommittee

## **ANALYSIS**

Planning staff compiled a draft work plan for review by the Planning Commission. Planning Commission duties are largely responsive to development applications submitted by the public and City Council initiated requests. The Planning Commission also holds several study sessions annually to discuss and analyze important planning issues and trends. Anticipated study sessions include Commercial Parking Pick-Up Stalls, South El Camino Real Mixed-Use Zoning Districts Development Update, Historic Preservation Training, and Planning Legislative Updates.
