Tin Can Toss



WHAT YOU NEED: 1 SIX PACK OF BOTTLED BEVERAGES

WRAPPING PAPER

TAPE

SCISSORS

3 HARD BRACELETS



HOW TO MAKE IT: DRINK ALL OF THE ROOT BEER AND CLEAN OUT THE BOTTLES TAKE THE CARDBOARD CONTAINER THAT THE SODA CAME IN AND CUT OFF THE HANDLE AND THEN WRAP IT IN THE WRAPPING PAPER (MAKE SURE THAT YOU LEAVE THE SLOTS FOR THE SODA BOTTLES OPEN – YOU WILL BE PUTTING THESE BACK IN.). PLACE THE CLEAN BOTTLES BACK IN THE CARDBOARD CARRIER. USE HARD BRACELETS (BANGLES) AS YOUR RINGS AND START TOSSING!



WHAT YOU NEED: 6 EMPTY TIN CANS

GLUE

TAPE

SCRAPBOOK PAPER

SCISSORS

3 SOFTBALLS



HOW TO MAKE IT: TAKE THE EMPTY CANS AND CLEAN THEM THOROUGHLY REMOVING ALL ORIGINAL LABELING. ONCE DRY, LAY THE CAN FLAT ON A PIECE OF SCRAPBOOK PAPER TO MEASURE HOW BIG A PIECE OF PAPER YOU WILL NEED TO COVER THE CAN. CUT THE SCRAPBOOK PAPER. APPLY TAPE TO ONE SIDE OF THE SCRAPBOOK PAPER AND ADHERE IT TO THE TIN CAN. APPLY GLUE TO THE PAPER AND WRAP IT AROUND THE TIN CAN. ONCE THE PAPER HAS BEEN GLUED ON AND IS DRY THESE CANS CAN BE STACKED TO FORM A TRIANGLE. SET UP THE TIN CANS, USE THE SOFTBALLS TO THROW AT THE CANS TO TRY AND KNOCK THEM DOWN.
