- OCTA Executive Director, Planning and Development
- OCTA is a multi-modal transportation planning agency, \$1.2 billion dollar annual budget
- OCTA is responsible for comprehensive transportation planning in Orange County, using a regional approach to improve mobility for the people that live and work in Orange County

OCTA Investments in 5th District



Transit

- \$ 24.9 million in multi-year grants for 21 Community Based Transit/Circulator projects and planning studies
- \$ 174 million in rail improvements such as station amenities, grade crossing improvements, and safety enhancements



Environmental

- \$ 9.1 million awarded to 49 water quality improvement projects
- Approximately 880 acres acquired and preserved as open space, 200 acres restored, and 14 dams removed

OCTA Investments in 5th District



Freeways

- \$ 232 million I-5 Improvement Project completed this year
- \$ 81 million State Route 74 Ortega interchange rebuilt
- \$ 550 million Upcoming I-5 Improvement Project between SR-73/El Toro Road



Streets and Roads

- \$ 75.7 million awarded to 26 Regional Capacity Projects
- \$ 16.3 million awarded to synchronize 767 signals
- \$ 56.1 million in Local Fair Share funds distributed to 5th District cities and the County to preserve streets and roads
