



Carbon Monoxide and Smoke Alarm Self-Certification

California Residential Code (CRC) Section R314 and R315 require in part that existing dwellings have smoke and carbon monoxide alarms installed when a building permit is issued for work on the building that exceeds \$1,000.

For more info, see handouts BI-34 and BI-35 posted on our website.

Additionally – California Health & Safety Code Section 13113.7 requires that all existing dwelling units were to have approved smoke detectors installed on or after January 1, 1987.

The City is unable to gain access to the interior of the home as all improvements under this permit are located exclusively on the exterior of the home. In lieu of interior inspection for carbon monoxide and smoke alarms by the City Inspector, this certification may be completed and presented to the City Building Inspector prior to final sign-off of permits for:

- Reroof permits
- Replacement of exterior wall cover permits
- Window change out permits
- Patio Cover permits

I further certify smoke detector(s) exist or have been installed in ALL the locations listed in accordance with the manufacturer's instructions for smoke and carbon monoxide alarms and have been tested and are operational.
