## DOG ACCESS TO BEACHES AND PARKS SURVEY City seeks public input on dog access, including beaches and parks

March 23, 2021....San Clemente, California....The City of San Clemente Beaches, Parks & Recreation Commission and Recreation Division is seeking public input regarding dog amenities and dog access to public spaces including beaches and parks. The Beaches, Parks and Recreation Commission is currently considering and will be discussing dog access to City beaches at its next regularly scheduled meeting on Tuesday, April 13, 2021 at 6:00pm. Additionally, the City has begun the process of updating site specific park master plans of five parks: Bonito Canyon Park, Linda Lane Park, Richard T. Steed Memorial Park/Baron Von Willard Dog Park, San Gorgonio Park, and San Luis Rey Park. Taking just a moment to complete a survey regarding dog access will help form future discussions regarding dog access and amenities in San Clemente.
