Captain Manhart reported O.C.S.D. will begin filming a bicycle safety review to include regular bicycles and E-bikes.

Chief Capobianco reported on the outreach efforts by O.C.F.A. to vaccinate sheltered homeless against Covid-19.

Captain Mellott reported the 2021 Junior Lifeguard Program is in motion and swim tests for new participants are underway. The Rookie Training Academy will

have 13 cadets, begins this weekend and will continue for five consecutive weekends totaling 100 hours of training. Lifeguard towers will be open April 3 – April 11, 2021 and the main towers open weekends weather permitting. Marine Safety created a 20-minute video on Beach and Ocean Safety that is available on the City’s website and on the City’s YouTube channel.
