

ORDINANCE NO. 1713

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN CLEMENTE, CALIFORNIA, REPEALING ORDINANCES NOS. 1684, 1697 AND 1710 RELATING TO THE BEACHES, PARKS AND RECREATION COMMISSION, PLANNING COMMISSION, GOLF COURSE COMMITTEE, HUMAN AFFAIRS COMMITTEE, COASTAL ADVISORY COMMITTEE, AND/OR THE INVESTMENT ADVISORY COMMITTEE

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of San Clemente adopted Ordinance No. 1684 on February 4, 2020, to implement structural and compositional changes to various City commissions and committees, with the stipulation that it become operational on July 1, 2020; and

WHEREAS, because of the Covid-19 pandemic, the City Council adopted Ordinance No. 1697 on May 19, 2020, to delay the implementation of Ordinance No. 1684 to July 1, 2021; and

WHEREAS, the City Council subsequently adopted Ordinance No. 1710 on February 2, 2021 to retain the City Council representative on the Investment Advisory Committee that was identified in Ordinance No. 1684 to be eliminated effective July 1, 2021; and

WHEREAS, the City Council desires to further assess the structure and composition of the City's commissions and committees, especially relating to possible consolidation of certain City bodies and/or reduced membership levels to enhance efficiency in terms of staff usage and resources; and

WHEREAS, to accommodate the additional study identified above, the City Council extended the terms of all incumbents of the City's standing commissions and committees, with the exception of the members of the Planning Commission, from June 30, 2021 to August 30, 2021; and

WHEREAS, Ordinance No. 1684, if allowed to become operational on July 1, 2021, would conflict with the extension of the terms of the existing members of the City's seven-member commissions and committees, because Ordinance No. 1684 mandates that the membership of those City bodies be reduced from seven to five; and

WHEREAS, the City Council desires to repeal Ordinances Nos. 1684, 1697 and 1710 to allow the status quo with regard to City commissions and committees to remain in effect pending Council adoption of new Ordinances that encompass all desired changes to the structure, composition and operation of the City's commissions and committees.

NOW, THEREFORE, the City Council of the City of San Clemente, California, hereby ordains as follows:

Section 1: Ordinance No. 1684, relating to various changes to City commissions and committees, is hereby repealed in its entirety and shall not take effect.

Section 2: Ordinance No. 1697, which extended the effective date of Ordinance No. 1684 from July 1, 2020 to July 1, 2021, is hereby repealed in its entirety and shall not take effect.

Section 3: Ordinance No. 1710, which restored the City Council representative position on the Investment Advisory Committee, that was slated to be eliminated upon the enactment of Ordinance No. 1684, is hereby repealed in its entirety and shall not take effect.
