Members of the public are requested to submit their comments by completing the Public Comment Submittal portal available from the City's website at www.san-clemente.org/HACPublicComment. Users of the on-line portal must indicate whether they wish their comments to be read aloud at the Human Affairs Committee meeting, or forwarded to Committee members via email. All comments become part of the public record. Comments to be read at the meetings are limited to a maximum of three minutes per speaker per item and will only be read if they are received prior to the commencement of the item to which the comment pertains. Comments received after deliberations begin will not be read at the meeting, but will be email to Committee members after the meeting.
