SOLID WASTE AND RECYCLING GUIDE







REMEMBER ON COLLECTION DAY

- 1 The carts should be placed at the curbside no later than 6:30 am on collection day and removed from the curbside within 12 hours after service.
- 2 The carts should be placed with the handles and wheels facing towards your home.
- **3** Place carts side-by-side approximately 1 foot apart & at least 3 feet from any obstruction (i.e. vehicles, fire hydrants, trees).
- 4 Items placed outside of carts will not be collected. Cart lids should be closed. Please do not overload.

ITEMS FOR RECYCLING CART

- Glass
- Plastic
- Metal
- Paper



ITEMS FOR ORGANICS CART

- Meat / Fish / Dairy
- Fruits / Vegetables
- Bread
- · Coffee & Filter
- FOG (Fats, oil, grease)
- Grass Clippings
- · Leaves / Weeds
- Flowers
- Wood Scraps / Chips
- Green Plants
- *Palm fronds are not recyclable and should be placed in your landfill cart.

ADDITIONAL SERVICES AVAILABLE

BULKY ITEM COLLECTION

Items that cannot fit in your automated carts are considered bulky items. Bulky items must be manageable by a two-person crew.

Examples of Bulky Items include:

Couches • Tables • Desks • Mattresses • Chairs • Excessive green waste

Each residential customer is entitle to (4) bulky item pick-ups free of charge per calendar year. A bulky item service may include a combination of large items or bags of materials. Additional pick-ups may be arranged for a nominal charge.

WHITE GOODS

White Goods or household appliances containing Freon are picked up similar to a bulky item. Refrigerators contain Freon and other chemicals that require special handling. CR&R will collect bulky items and white goods from your curbside.

E-WASTE

Electronic Waste (e-waste) is anything with a circuit board or battery powered. It is illegal to dispose of e-waste in any of your automated carts. CR&R will collect and legally dispose of and recycle these items via our bulky item collection service.

Hazardous wastes are products that are flammable, corrosive, reactive or toxic. This includes batteries of all types, as they are considered hazardous waste in California when they are discarded. Therefore, it is illegal to dispose of them in regular trash or recycling; so don't place them in CR&R containers. This includes batteries of all types and sizes Alkaline (AAA, AA, C, D, 9 volt), Lithium (button cell, power tool batteries, camera batteries, other electronics), Ni-Cad (power tools), and battery types both rechargeable and single use. Batteries can be collected as part of your service or taken to one of the following:

- household hazardous waste disposal facility
- local retailer (Home Depot, Lowes, Best Buy, Staples, Ikea, etc.)

Why is it important? When lithium batteries are improperly disposed of they can cause fires in recycling centers, landfills, and garbage and recycling trucks.

Examples of HHW include:

Fluorescent light tubes • Household batteries • Latex or water based paint Non empty aerosol cans • Thermostats • High intensity discharge lamps

Collection of these items is part of your service.

You may contact CR&R Customer Service and make arrangements for a special door side collection of HHW items. The Customer Service Representative will ask you for a specific number and list of items. This is required by law in order to collect the material. Please be prepared with this information.

SHARPS

Disposal of needles, lancets and other home-generated sharps in your trash and recycling bins is hazardous and illegal. Needles, lancets and other home generated sharps may be collected as part of your service in an approved puncture proof container. Contact CR&R Customer Service and make arrangements for a special door side collection of Sharps.
