A. Education Topic: Homelessness

<u>Nikki Buckstead</u>, Executive Director, Family Solutions Collaborative (FSC), provided an overview and answered questions regarding the organization, service providers, FSC access points, requirements to receive services, and developing a housing plan.

<u>Donna Vidrine</u>, Homeless Collaborative, thanked the Committee for inviting her to participate in the Human Affairs Committee meeting. Ms. Vidrine stated that the Collaborative advocates for a strategy to provide shelter and professional services for the homeless that are living on the streets and in public spaces within the City. She highlighted the Fullerton Navigation Center that is operated by the Illumination Foundation as an excellent program.

<u>Lana Fiore</u>, iHope, discussed the organization, their primary clientele, temporary housing, and the affects COVID-19 have had on the homeless community.

4. SPECIAL OR PUBLIC PRESENTATION

<u>Susan Parmelee</u> and <u>Susan Hill</u>, Wellness and Prevention Center, provided a brief overview of the organization and announced an upcoming fundraiser, "Family Fun Fest", to take place in April 2022 to assist in bringing awareness to mental health and wellness.
