CONSTRUCTION CONTRACT AWARD TO GCI CONSTRUCTION, INC. FOR THE STORM

DRAIN IMPROVEMENTS AT N. EL CAMINO REAL AND CAMINO SAN CLEMENTE. CIP

PROJECT No. 10016.

Fiscal Impact: Yes. The estimated total project cost of \$332,250 is within the approved project budget of \$836,000 available from the Storm Drain Improvements at N. El

Camino Real and Camino San Clemente, CIP Project No. 10016.

Summary:

Background:

Staff recommends approval of a construction contract with GCI Construction. Inc. for a total amount not to exceed \$249,750 for the purpose of replacing catch basins and storm drain pipe at N. El Camino Real and Camino San Clemente.

The catch basins at the intersection of North El Camino Real and Camino San Clemente are in need of replacement and upgrades. The connecting 24-inch reinforced concrete pipes (RCP) are also in need of repairs and will be lined with polyvinyl chloride (PVC) material to extend their service lives. Additionally, screen protections for collecting debris and other sediments will be installed at the face of the outlets of these new catch basins to satisfy the water quality requirements.

The project was advertised for competitive bidding on the PlanetBids website and bids were received on July 1, 2021. Bids ranged from \$249,750 to \$373,255, as shown on Attachment 2. The lowest responsive bidder was GCI Construction, San Clemente, California with a total bid of \$249,750. Based on the low bid, project costs are estimated as follows:

Construction Contract	\$249,750
Construction Management, Administration	
Soil testing and Inspection	45,000
Project Contingency (15%)	37,500
Total Estimated Construction Costs	\$332,250

The approved project budget available is \$836,000. A portion of the original budgeted scope of work included work within the railroad right-of-way, owned by the Orange County Transportation Authority (OCTA). During the permit coordination processing with OCTA, OCTA denied approval of the improvements within its right-of-way due to potential overburdening of OCTA's

downstream storm drain system, resulting in reduction of the City's scope of work. Upon completion of the project, the unused project fund balance will return to the Storm Drain Fund Depreciation Reserve.

As required by City Policy and State Law, the Contractor will be required to provide performance and payment bonds simultaneously with execution of the construction contract (Attachment 3). A warranty bond will also be required prior to City Council acceptance of the project. Project plans and specifications are on file in the City Clerk's office.

- 1. Approve the Plans and Specifications for the Storm Drain Improvements at N. El Camino Real & Camino San Clemente, CIP Project No. 10016; and
- Approve and authorize the Interim Public Works Director to execute Contract No. _____, by and between the City of San Clemente and GCI Construction, Inc., in the amount not to exceed of \$249,750, for the Storm Drain Improvements at N. El Camino Real and Camino San Clemente, CIP Project No. 10016.



SECTION 00500 CONTRACT

THIS CONTRACT is made this _____ day of _____, 2021, in the County of Orange, State of California, by and between the City of San Clemente hereinafter called City, and GCI Construction, Inc., hereinafter called Contractor. City and the Contractor for the considerations stated herein agree as follows:

ARTICLE 1. SCOPE OF WORK. The Contractor shall perform all Work within the time stipulated the contract and shall provide all labor, materials, equipment, tools, utility services, and transportation to complete all of the Work required in strict compliance with the Contract Documents as specified in Article 5 below for the following Project:

STORM DRAIN IMPROVEMENTS AT N. EL CAMINO REAL & CAMINO SAN CLEMENTE, PROJECT NO. 10016

The Contractor and its surety shall be liable to City for any damages arising as a result of the Contractor's failure to comply with this obligation.

ARTICLE 2. TIME FOR COMPLETION. The Work shall be commenced on the date stated in City's Notice to Proceed. The Contractor shall complete all Work required by the Contract Documents within Sixty (60) Working Days from the complete complete the Work required by the Contractor Documents within Sixty (60) Working Days from the complete the Work required by the Contractor agrees the time for completion set forth above is adequate and reasonable to complete the Work.

ARTICLE 3. CONTRACT PRICE. City shall be not the Contractor as full compensation for the performance of the Contract, subject to any additions or deductions as provided in the Contract Documents, and including all applicable taxes and costs, the sum of Two Hundred Forty Nine thousand Seven Hundred Fifty Dollars (\$229.750). Payment shall be made as set forth in the General Conditions.

At any time during the term of the Contract, City may, pursuant to the terms and provisions of the Contract Documents, request that the Contractor perform additional work. Contractor shall not perform, nor be compensated for additional work without written authorization from the City pursuant to the terms and provisions of the Contract Documents.

ARTICLE 4. LIQUIDATED DAMAGES/EARLY COMPLETION INCENTIVE. In accordance with Government Code section 53069.85, it is agreed that the Contractor will pay City the sum of \$1,000 for each and every calendar day of delay beyond the time prescribed in the Contract Documents for finishing the Work, as Liquidated Damages and not as a penalty or forfeiture. In the event that Liquidated Damages are not paid, the Contractor agrees City may deduct that amount from any money due or that may become due the Contractor under the Contract. This Article does not exclude recovery of other damages specified in the Contract Documents.

ARTICLE 5. COMPONENT PARTS OF THE CONTRACT. The "Contract Documents" include the following:

ARTICLE 6. PROVISIONS REQUIRED BY AW Each and every provision of law required to be included in these Contract Documents. The Contractor shall comply with all requirements of applicable federal, state and local laws, rules and regulations, including that not mitted to, the provisions of the California Labor Code and California Public Contract Code which are applicable to this Project.

ARTICLE 7. INDEMNIFICATION. Contractor shall provide indemnification as set forth in the General Conditions.

ARTICLE 8. PREVAILING WASES. Contractor shall be required to pay the prevailing rate of wages in accordance with the labor Code which such rates shall be made available at City of San Clemente Public Works Department or may be obtained online at http://www.dir.ca.gov/dlsr.and which must be posted at the job site.
